Georgius Agricola

Georgius Agricola ([/əˈɡrɪkələ/](#); 24 March 1494 – 21 November 1555) was a [German](#) Catholic, scholar and scientist. Known as "the father of [mineralogy](#)", he was born at [Glauchau](#) in [Saxony](#). His birth name was **Georg Pawer** (*Bauer* in modern German);^[4] *Agricola* is the [Latinized](#) version of his name, by which he was known his entire adult life; *Agricola* and *Bauer* mean "farmer" in their respective languages. He is best known for his book [De Re Metallica](#) (1556).

Georg Agricola Medallion



At its General Meeting in Freiberg/Saxony in 1924, the society initiated a silver medallion carrying the name "Georg Agricola Medallion" in memory of the founder of the scientific treatment of mineralogy and of mining and smelting processes. It is awarded for outstanding achievements in the areas of mining and smelting through which essential progress has been made in these branches of technology from a scientific, practical or economic standpoint. The award takes place according to a mutual decision by the Presiding Committee and the Advisory Committee of the society.
